

Installation & Clearances : Traditional

Installation The Traditional Grate itself does not require any assembly, it is simply placed into a fixed secure position as per instructions within the operation manual.

Clearances **CONVERSION OF AN EXISTING FIREPLACE:**
The grate can only be fitted into a fireplace opening that has the following minimum clearances:
W 650mm [25.6in] × H 800mm [31.5in] × D 500mm [19.7in]

The fireplace surround and base must be made out of a non-combustible material such as stainless steel, brick, concrete etc.

INSERING WITHOUT A FIREBOX SETTING:

REAR: A minimum 30mm [1.20in] space between the burner and the rear wall.

FRONT: A minimum of 45mm [1.75in] space between the burner and the front edge.

OVERHEAD: A minimum clearance of 1500mm [59.05in].

SIDES: A minimum clearance of 600mm [25.60in] from the Burner.

BASE: Must be made of non-combustible material.

The **Traditional Grate** is heavy – handle with care.

The **Traditional Grate** can not be operated before it is installed in a fixed secure position. Use common sense to ensure that it is positioned away from curtains, flammable goods and other sources of ignition. Be aware of drafts.
